

Brand new Yahoo Store set up for new credit card processing:

- 1. From the Open for Business Control Panel click Payment Methods
- 2. Click Set Up My First Payment Method
- 3. Select the Yes option
- 4. Select the Existing Business Account option, click Next
- 5. Enter your account information enclosed in your Welcome Letter from eMerchant (see Section A below)

Existing Yahoo Store, change credit card processors:

First, you must either cancel or settle all open Authorizations. Then, you must Batch out.

- From Store Manager, click the Payment Center link under the Order Settings column (You may be prompted to enter your security key to proceed)
- 2. Click Add New Processor
- 3. Select the option to use your existing payment processor
- 4. Select the option to configure an existing merchant account and click Next
- 5. Enter your account information enclosed in your Welcome Letter from eMerchant (see Section A below)
